

Justice On Sin City

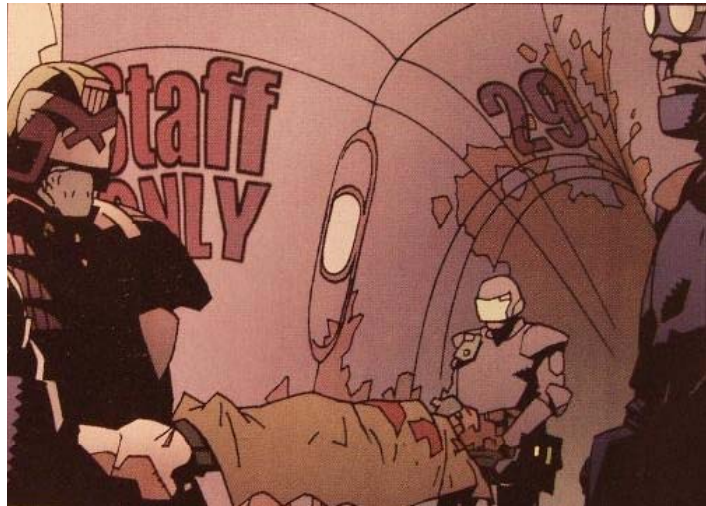
